

Congenital Rectovaginal Defect and Atresia Ani in A four week old Local Puppy: A Case Report

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ABSTRACT

Rectovaginal defect and atresia ani were diagnosed in a four-week-old female local puppy. Complications included urinary and fecal incontinence, constipation and retarded growth. On necropsy at ten weeks of age, there was a well developed, patent rectum which terminated directly on the vagina. A rectovagina fistula was absent. The tail was also absent.
