ABSTRACT

The research on survey of wild animals use in the treatment of Asthma in Abeokuta was conducted and the result showed that 100 percent of respondents, were male at which 45% were Native Doctors, 75% had Non-formal education .Also highest percentages was recorded in practices experience which is between 31-35 years according to the respondent observation and the year of specialization offered by respondents' showed that 21-25 years had the highest specialization period respectively. The result of the research also revealed that the lungs of Fox, Hyena and Wild dog the highest percentage part of wild animal that can be used. It was also observed that the highest percentage of animal sources is mainly from the wild forest.

The general cost of animals part used in the treating asthma was ranging from N300 to N100,000 and the dry and wet seasons has more abundant sources of wild animal in treating asthma.

Observation also shows that the highest duration of treating asthma is 3 months are 44 percent were completely healed, 21 percent were pleased with the treatment while 11 percent respondent was good and effective and 5 percent thank God and appreciate.

The highest of charges for the treatment of asthma ranges between N10, 000 – N60, 000 according to research.
